From my experiences, there are some brands that do have a quality difference and for these items I have included my recommendations. The grade fives (may) have lockers and desk drawers. It will be expected that they show up to each class with the required materials which will be housed in their lockers. Students will bring their pencil case, water bottle, and binder to class.

	<b>Chromebook</b> We encourage students to bring their own device for their schoolwork. Chromebooks are the most cost friendly option.
